


Schleching - Lake Taubensee - Kössen

HIKING TOUR

Geigelstein car park in Ettenhausen - Achberg- Streichen, past the Chiemhauser Alm - Kroatensteig to the Taubensee-Taubenseehütte and descent to Kössen Tirol.



Mountain hikeRefreshment options: Petereralm (*); Chiemhauser Alm (*); Taubenseehütte (*) (*) typical alpine snack, coffee and cake during the alpine grazing season (please note opening times)Achental hiking pin Checkpoints: Achberg; Chiemhauser Alm; Taubensee; Special features: beautiful, refreshing mountain lake with swimming facilities; rare crabs in the lake; bizarre rock holes on the lake shoreTip: to cool off, take your bathing suit and jump into the Taubensee Description: The starting point is the Geigelstein car park in Ettenhausen. After a short hike along the road, the path leads up to the Achberg car park in the direction of the Streichenkirche and the Berggasthof am Streichen. The climb now leads through an extensive alpine area. The steep "Kroatensteig" then leads over the saddle at the "Rauhe Nadel" and down to the Taubensee and the German-Austrian border, marked by an old border guard's house. After a few minutes, you reach the Taubenseehütte (1165 m). Located high above the valley of Kössen, you can expect a wonderful panoramic view of the much-praised Zahmen (2001m) and Wilder Kaiser (highest point - Ellmauer Halt at 2344m). From there, we head down to the neighboring town of Kössen/Tirol to the local tourist information office. There we get on the 9509 bus at the "VZ Kaiserwinkl" bus stop in the direction of Schleching. After a short drive, we reach the destination stop "Ettenhausen Zollamt". Bus connection 9509 from Kössen to Schleching (cross-border Austria - Germany): www.dbregiobus-bayern.de
